

## To sole owners or undivided co-owners of an immovable and to sole occupants or co-occupants of a business establishment entitled to be entered on the list of electors of the City of Dorval

**PUBLIC NOTICE** is hereby given by Chantale Bilodeau, Returning Officer:

TO THE SOLE OWNERS OF AN IMMOVABLE AND THE SOLE OCCUPANTS OF A BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENT in the municipality, who are not already entitled to be entered on the list of electors as a domiciled person, that they can be entered on the municipal list of electors for the municipal election of November 7, 2021, if they meet the following conditions:

- 1. be at least 18 years of age on November 7, 2021;
- 2. <u>be a natural person</u>, a Canadian citizen, not be under curatorship on September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021 and, on that date, not have been convicted, over the last five years, of an offence that is a corrupt electoral practice;
- be the sole owner of an immovable or sole occupant of a business establishment situated in the territory of the municipality for at least 12 months on September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021;
- 4. have sent to the municipality, at the address indicated below, an application for entry on the list of electors not later than October 18, 2021.

## AND

TO THE UNDIVIDED CO-OWNERS OF AN IMMOVABLE AND CO-OCCUPANTS OF A BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENT of the municipality, who are not already entitled to be entered on the list of electors as a domiciled person, sole owner of an immovable or sole occupant of a business establishment, that they can be entered on the municipal list of electors for the **municipal election of November 7, 2021**, if they meet the following conditions:

- 1. be at least 18 years of age on November 7, 2021;
- 2. <u>be a natural person</u>, a Canadian citizen, not be under curatorship on September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021 and, on that date, not have been convicted, over the last five years, of an offence that is a corrupt electoral practice;
- 3. be the undivided co-owner of an immovable or co-occupant of a business establishment situated in the territory of the municipality for at least 12 months on September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021;
- have been designated by means of a power of attorney signed by the majority of the co-owners or cooccupants who are electors on September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021;
- 5. have sent to the municipality, at the address indicated below, an application for entry on the list of electors not later than October 18, 2021.

**TAKE NOTE** that applications for entry and powers of attorney take effect upon their receipt and remain valid until they are withdrawn or replaced.
