PUBLIC CONSULTATION MEETING

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given to all interested person.

1. At a sitting held on July 12, 2021, the Municipal Council adopted the following draft by-law:

RCM-60A-14-2021: By-law further amending Zoning By-law RCM-60A-2015 to integrate the new provisions of the provincial by-law on residential swimming pool safety.

The purpose of this by-law is to comply with the new rules imposed by the Quebec Government on the safety of residential swimming pools, regardless of their date of installation, in order to reduce the risk of drowning for young children.

2. In accordance with the government requirements due to COVID-19 any procedure that is part of a municipality's decision-making process and that requires citizens to travel must be accompanied by a 15 day written consultation. Consequently, any interested person or body may be heard by the Council as follows:

- By attending the public consultation meeting that will be held on Monday, August 23, 2021, at 7:45 p.m. at the Sarto-Desnoyers Community Centre, Salon D, 1335 chemin du Bord-du-Lac – Lakeshore, Dorval. At the said meeting, the Mayor or another designated person will explain the draft by-law described above and will hear any person or body wishing to express an opinion; or
- By transmitting their comments by email to greffe@ville.dorval.qc.ca or by mail to the attention of the undersigned, 60 Martin, Avenue, Dorval, H9S 3R4. The comments must be received by the undersigned no later than 4 p.m. on August 23, 2021, with the subject line 'Public consultation'. An audio recording of the meeting will be available on the City's website as of August 25, 2021.

4. The draft by-law is available on the City's website: www.city.dorval.qc.ca, on the Municipal By-Laws page, in the Draft By-Laws section. This document may also be consulted at the office of the undersigned, 60 Martin Avenue, Dorval, from Monday to Friday, during regular business hours.

5. This draft by-law does not contain provisions that are subject to approval by way of a referendum.
