# DRAFT BY-LAW RCM-71.1-2022 AMENDING BY-LAW RCM-71-2019 ON THE REMUNERATION OF ELECTED MUNICIPAL OFFICERS

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given, according to section 9 of the *Act respecting the remuneration of elected municipal officers*, chapter T-11.001, that at the Council meeting held on December 12, 2022, a draft by-law entitled 'By-law amending By-law RCM-71-2019 concerning the remuneration of elected municipal officers in order to cap their annual indexation rate' was tabled.

#### Summary of the draft by-law

This draft by-law aims to amend Section 3 of By-law No. RCM-71-2019 concerning the remuneration of elected municipal officers so as to cap the annual indexation rate of elected officers' remunerations provided for in the said by-law. The basic remuneration paid to elected officials is not increased by this draft by-law. This aims to introduce a ceiling of 2.25% of annual indexation for all the remunerations paid to them, namely: the basic remuneration, the expense allowance as well as the additional remuneration payable for the attendance at certain committees.

### Proposed content of Section 3

'The remunerations fixed in the present by-law are indexed upwards for each fiscal year, by a percentage corresponding to the Consumer Price Index rate of increase established for the whole of Quebec by Statistics Canada, **up to a maximum cap of 2.25 % per fiscal year**.'

## Place, date and scheduled time of the adoption of the by-law

By-law RCM-71.1-2022 will be submitted to the Municipal Council for adoption at the meeting to be held on January 23, 2023, in the chapel of the "Quatre Vents" residence, 12 Dahlia Avenue, Dorval, Quebec, at 7 p.m.
