<u>RCM-91-2022:</u> Interim Control By-law to initiate a reflection on the vocation of the area located between Highway 20, Côte-de-Liesse Road and 55<sup>th</sup> Avenue

**RCM-60B-1-2022:** By-law amending the Subdivision By-law RCM-60B-2015 in order to amend the provisions applicable to the contribution required for the purposes of parks, playgrounds and natural areas

<u>RCM-60C-3-2022:</u> By-law further amending the Site Planning and Architectural Integration Program By-law RCM-60C-2015 in order to correct an error and to introduce new regulatory provisions to better regulate the installation of solar panels and other solar energy systems
