<u>RCM-60B-1-2022:</u> By-law amending the Subdivision By-law RCM-60B-2015 in order to modify the provisions of the contribution required for the purposes of parks, playgrounds and natural areas.

<u>RCM-60C-3-2022:</u> By-law to further amend the Site Planning and Architectural Integration Program By-law RCM-60C-2015 in order to correct an error and to introduce new provisions providing a better framework for the installation of solar panels and other solar energy systems.
