

**PUBLIC CONSULTATION MEETING**

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given to all interested persons.

1. At a sitting held on March 21, 2022, the Municipal Council adopted the following draft by-laws:

RCM-60A-15-2022: By-law to further amend the Zoning By-law RCM-60A-2015 in order to correct errors or omissions and to improve the by-law.

RCM-60B-1-2022: By-law amending the Subdivision By-law RCM-60B-2015 in order to modify the provisions of the contribution required for the purposes of parks, playgrounds and natural areas.

RCM-60C-3-2022: By-law to further amend the Site Planning and Architectural Integration Program By-law RCM-60C-2015 in order to correct an error and to introduce new provisions providing a better framework for the installation of solar panels and other solar energy systems.

2. A public consultation meeting will take place on April 14, 2022, 7 p.m. at the Sarto-Desnoyers Community Centre, Salon D, 1335 chemin du Bord-du-Lac – Lakeshore, Dorval. At the said meeting, the Mayor, or another designated person, will explain the draft by-laws described above and will hear any person or body wishing to express an opinion.
3. The draft by-laws are available for consultation at the office of the City Clerk, 60 Martin Avenue, Dorval, from Monday to Friday, during regular business hours and on the City's website at [www.ville.dorval.qc.ca](http://www.ville.dorval.qc.ca).
4. Only the Zoning draft By-law RCM-60A-15-2022 contains provisions making it a by-law subject to approval by way of a referendum.
