1. That at a regular meeting held on November 20, 2023, the Council adopted the draft By-law RCM-95-1-2023 entitled: 'By-law amending By-law RCM-95-2023 concerning the imposition of a contribution to finance all or part of an expense related to any addition to or enlargement or alteration of municipal infrastructures or equipment in order to update the costs of equipment and infrastructures to be financed according to the number of planned housing units'.

This draft by-law aims to amend sections 2 and 6 as well as Schedule A of By-law RCM-95-2023 in order to add a definition of the terms "Hotel or motel" and to describe how the contribution amounts are determined.

Prescribed zones: The whole territory of the City of Dorval.

At the said meeting, the Mayor, or a person designated by him, will explain the draft by-law described above and will hear any individual or organization wishing to express an opinion.
- 3. The draft by-law amending By-law RCM-95-2023 is available for consultation at the Public Affairs and Registry Department, 60 Martin Avenue, Dorval, during business hours or on the City's website at http://www.city.dorval.gc.ca, on the "Draft by-laws" page.
- 4. This by-law contains no provisions that are subject to approval by way of a referendum pursuant to the Act respecting land use planning and development.
