PUBLIC CONSULTATION MEETING

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given to all interested persons:

- At a regular meeting held on September 18, 2023, the Municipal Council of the City of Dorval adopted the following draft by-laws:
 - a) <u>RCM-60-PU.2-2023</u>: By-law to further amend the Sustainable Master Plan 2015-2031 n° RCM-60-PU-2015 in order to include new orientations for its requalification sectors, a delimitation of the perimeter of the Michel-Jasmin Special Planning Program (SPP) and a building heights map.


This draft by-law introduces the following modifications:


- Addition of a Special Planning Program (SPP) for the Michel-Jasmin sector delimited as follows: lots included within zones I05-15, I05-16, C05-13 and I05-14 excluding its northern part of Avenue Michel Jasmin as illustrated in By-law n° RCM-91-1-2023 modifying the interim By-law n° RCM-91-2022.
- Introduction of new development guidelines for sectors newly identified as "Requalification Sectors", namely the Old Village, Dawson South/Dorval East (including the Garden Crescent), Dorval Avenue East, Herron Road/Fénélon Boulevard, Montréal-Toronto Boulevard, Bouchard Boulevard, Michel-Jasmin SPP and TOD Area Des Sources sectors.
- Introduction of a maximum heights map in the requalification sectors to encourage the development and densification of these sectors while respecting existing built areas.
- b) <u>RCM-60A-16-2023</u>: Concordance By-law to further amend Zoning By-law n° RCM-60A-2015 in order to ensure the conformity of certain provisions of said by-law with the modified Sustainable Master Plan 2015-2031 n° RCM-60-PU-2015.
 - This draft by-law modifies the schedules of uses and standards and the zoning plan applicable to the sectors affected by the amendments to the Sustainable Master Plan brought by draft by-law n° RCM-60-PU.2-2023 so that these Schedules comply with the modified Sustainable Master Plan.

Prescribed zones by By-law RCM-60A-16-2023: V01-83, H01-07, U01-24, U01-26, U01-28, U01-29, U02-29, C02-12, C02-30, C01-30, H01-62 (former zone C01-62), I05-14 (excluding its northern part), I05-15, I05-16 and C05-13.

- 2. A public consultation meeting will be held on Wednesday, October 11, 2023, 7 p.m., at the Sarto-Desnoyers Community Centre, Rooms A and B, located at 1335 chemin du Bord-du-Lac-Lakeshore, Dorval, Québec, H9S 2E5. At the said meeting, the Mayor, or a person designated by him, will explain the draft by-laws described above and will hear any individual or organization wishing to express an opinion.
- 3. This meeting will be webcast live and recorded, but only questions addressed in person during the public meeting will be accepted.
- 4. The draft by-laws are available for consultation at the Public Affairs and Registry Department, 60 Martin Avenue, Dorval, during business hours or on the City's website at www.city.dorval.qc.ca, on the "Draft by-laws" page.

5. These by-laws contain no provisions that are subject to approval by way of a referendum pursuant to the *Act respecting land use planning and development*.
