

PUBLIC NOTICE PUBLIC CONSULTATION MEETING

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given to persons who may be interested in draft By-law RCM-60H-2024:

- 1. At a regular sitting held on April 15, 2024, the Municipal Council of the City of Dorval adopted draft by-law **RCM-60H-2024** respecting Comprehensive Development Programs (CDP) in order to ensure the coherent and sustainable development of the territory of Garden Crescent.
- 2. The purpose of By-law RCM-60H-2024 is to establish a procedure to allow a development project in zone H01-07 that is at variance with the applicable urban planning by-laws by establishing objectives and evaluation criteria for projects located within zones subject to a CDP.
- 3. A public consultation meeting will take place on May 7, 2024, 6 p.m. at the Sarto-Desnoyers Community Centre, Salon A, 1335 chemin du Bord-du-Lac Lakeshore, Dorval. At the said public consultation, the Mayor, or another designated person, will explain the draft by-law described above and the consequence of its adoption, and will hear any person wishing to express an opinion on the subject.

- 6. The draft By-law RCM-60H-2024 contains no provisions that are subject to approval by way of a referendum pursuant to the *Act respecting land use planning and development*.
