

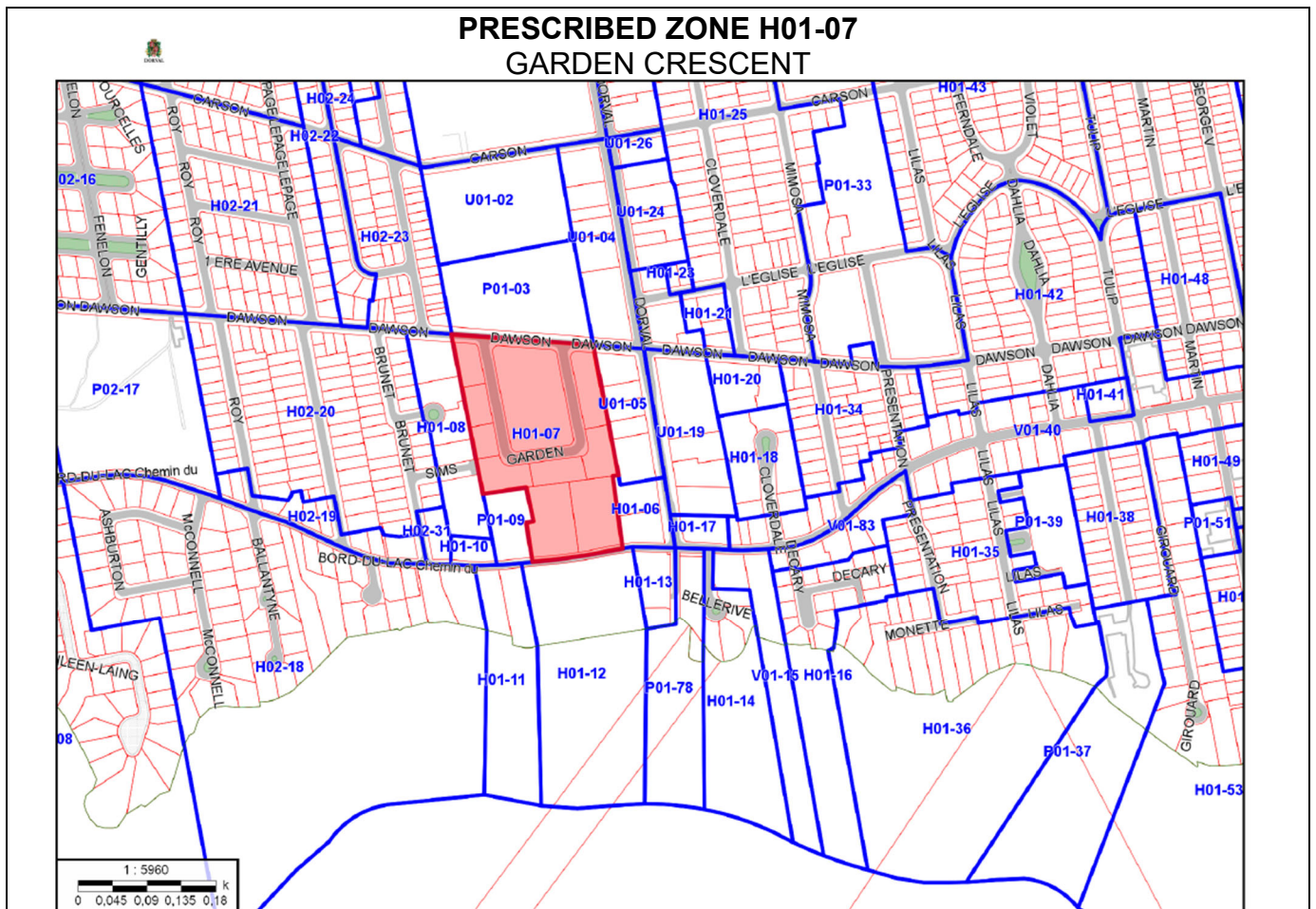

PUBLIC NOTICE
PUBLIC CONSULTATION MEETING

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given to persons who may be interested in draft By-law RCM-60H-2024:

1. At a regular sitting held on April 15, 2024, the Municipal Council of the City of Dorval adopted draft by-law **RCM-60H-2024** respecting Comprehensive Development Programs (CDP) in order to ensure the coherent and sustainable development of the territory of Garden Crescent.
2. The purpose of By-law RCM-60H-2024 is to establish a procedure to allow a development project in zone H01-07 that is at variance with the applicable urban planning by-laws by establishing objectives and evaluation criteria for projects located within zones subject to a CDP.
3. A public consultation meeting will take place on May 7, 2024, 6 p.m. at the Sarto-Desnoyers Community Centre, Salon A, 1335 chemin du Bord-du-Lac – Lakeshore, Dorval. At the said public consultation, the Mayor, or another designated person, will explain the draft by-law described above and the consequence of its adoption, and will hear any person wishing to express an opinion on the subject.
4. The prescribed zone H01-07 is illustrated in the sketch below:



5. The draft by-law is available for consultation at the office of the undersigned located at 60 Martin Avenue, Dorval, from Monday to Friday, during business hours and on the City's website at www.city.dorval.qc.ca, on the "Draft by-laws" page.
6. The draft By-law RCM-60H-2024 contains no provisions that are subject to approval by way of a referendum pursuant to the *Act respecting land use planning and development*.
