BY-LAW NO. RCA-09-04

BY-LAW CONCERNING SHOPPING CARTS ON WHEELS

Regular meeting of the Council of the Borough of Dorval/L'Ile-Dorval, held in the Council Chamber, 60 Martin Avenue, Dorval, Quebec, at 8:00 P.M. on Monday, December 6, 2004, Mr. Peter B. Yeomans, Mayor of the Borough, presiding.

AT WHICH WERE PRESENT :

Councillors Robert M. Bourbeau and Edgar Rouleau forming a complete quorum of the said Council.

Council resolves that it be and it is hereby ordained and decreed by the present by-law the following:

SECTION 1. Constitutes a nuisance and is prohibited the act of leaving the parking area of a commercial property with a shopping cart on wheels which belongs to a commercial establishment.

SECTION 2. For the removal, transportation and storage of any shopping cart on wheels found outside of the designated areas, a fine of twenty-five dollars (\$25.) will be imposed to the owner of the cart.

SECTION 3. The owner of a shopping cart on wheels for which the fine imposed by virtue of section 2 has not been paid may not take possession of said cart without first paying such fine.

SECTION 4. Should the owner of a cart fail to indicate his interest in recuperating such cart, the municipality may dispose of it 60 days after receipt of a second notice by the owner.

SECTION 5. Any person who contravenes a provision of this by-law, tolerates or permits such a contravention commits an infraction and is liable to a fine as follows:

a) for a first infraction: a minimum of FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.) and a maximum of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.).

b) for a subsequent offence: a minimum of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.) and a maximum of FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.).

SECTION 6. By-law no. 1489-00 and its amendments are hereby repealed.

SECTION 7. The present by-law comes into force according to law.
