Excerpt of the minutes of the council meeting held on Monday, September 20, 2021

#### 1b Question Period and Receipt of Petitions

1. A resident of Handfield Circle wishes much success to Mayor Rouleau and City Councillors who are not running in the next election for their future endeavours. She asks if the City is planning **repair work at the Ballantyne pool** next year, adding that the increase in housing will require more recreational infrastructures.
2. A resident of Oakville Avenue asks if a **temporary fence could be installed** where missing **between Herron Road and Highway 20 eastbound**, while waiting for the MTQ to make the necessary repairs.
3. A resident of Neptune Boulevard asks: 1) why the City doesn't specify in its publications that **green waste** can be disposed of in the garbage bins as it is permitted under the municipal by-law; and 2) why **household waste** is not always picked up on Mondays by the waste collection company, even if there is staff turnover which should not impact waste pickup.
4. A resident of St-Charles Avenue asks: 1) to **councillor Doret** why he did not announce earlier that he was intending on running for Mayor; 2) to **councillor Doret** why the **agendas and minutes** are so succinct compared to those of other municipalities, especially on items pertaining to the **awarding of contracts**; and 3) to councillor **von Roretz** why supports the awarding of contracts to two companies that have been said to be corrupted.
5. A resident of de La Présentation Avenue asks: 1) if the municipality has created a **Strategic Development Plan** and if extensive citizen participation was involved when designing this plan and if so, suggests it be released; 2) if the City has developed a **mobility plan** to improve road safety and secure bike paths, as suggested during the 2017 election campaign and supported by council; and 3) how the City plans to secure **traffic around schools** and finalize the **school-park project**.
