### 1b Question Period and Receipt of Petitions

1. The City Clerk mentions that she received **petitions** signed by 31 residents with regards to the **minor exemption** request at 120 Brockwell Avenue. She immediately reads aloud the wording of the petitions and the council members take note of them.

2. A resident of Lakeshore Drive asks: 1) why the City of Dorval cannot confirm that two intersections are in **violation** of municipal by-laws within a delay of ten (10) days, as is done by the City of Pointe-Claire 2) from who came the information claiming that he receives advertising revenue when someone opens his **blog**, and states that his blog is a free service with no fees, and which does not offer revenue in return, 3) what is the name and title of the person who ordered the removal of his **election signs** in October 2017 and whom M. Chevalier referred to when he went to pick them up from his office.

3. A resident of Dawson Avenue asks: 1) if the City has established guidelines to protect the **architectural heritage** in order to preserve the similarity of existing Dorval properties 2) how much the City paid to acquire **Pointe-Picard** 3) if phase 2 of the **environmental study** was completed for this site.

4. A resident of Saint-Charles Avenue asks: 1) why the Director General is so concerned about the demolition of **25 Sevigny** 2) what business advice he intended to give him at the **lunch meeting** which he had invited him to 3) why the Director General filters the responses to his **access to information requests**.
