

Excerpt of the minutes of the council meeting held on Monday, April 19, 2021

## CM2104 123

## 1b Question Period and Receipt of Petitions

- 1. A resident of Parkfield Avenue asks if the City could open up a discussion with its young adults to encourage them to vote in large numbers in the next **municipal elections**.
- 2. A resident of Linnet Crescent asks for the City's help to allow the **Dorval Preschool Coop** to reintegrate the Sarto-Desnoyers Community Centre, which is currently closed due to COVID-19. If this is not possible, she asks to be able to use any other room in another municipal building such as the Dorval Aquatic and Sports Complex, or to find another solution that will allow children to have access to the Coop's learning program.
- 3. A resident of Dawson Avenue asks : 1) who the City's chief engineer is; 2) if the traffic light at the intersection of Dorval Avenue and **chemin du Bord-du-Lac—Lakeshore** is working properly; and 3) if stop signs can be added on **chemin du Bord-du-Lac—Lakeshore** towards the village area to slow down traffic.
- 4. A resident of Clément Avenue again asks the City to intervene to find a solution to the increased presence of visitors at **Pine Beach Park** which prevents neighbouring properties from enjoying the tranquility and cleanliness of the area to which they are accustomed.
- 5. A resident of McNicoll Crescent, on her own behalf and that of two other residents, asks when Mayor Rouleau will agree to meet virtually with representatives of TechnoparcOiseaux and Regroupement QuébecOiseaux to respond to their requests of opening up **Golf Dorval** to winter activities to allow for winter sports and bird watching in the area.
- 6. A resident of St-Charles Avenue asks 1) if Mayor Rouleau intends to ask for the resignation of Margo Heron for allegedly breaking several city by-laws; 2) why the City accepts that the buyer of the land situated at 252 Clément is breaching the sale contract by transferring the property to his son; and 3) if Councillor von Roretz was aware that the City recorded the council meetings before the recordings were made public, whether he approved of such a practice, if he agrees that these recordings



should be made public, and whether he supports the City's claim that the recordings cannot be made public because they were disposed of.

- 7. A resident of de l'Académie Avenue asks 1) that the City require **Collège Ste-Anne** to plant a 10-foot cedar hedge to a provide a wall of privacy due to the proximity of her property to a new chalet that is currently under construction; and 2) that the chalet's main door be situated on the east side, with a view of the synthetic grounds, and not at the back of the chalet, with a view on her property.
- 8. A resident of Dubord Crescent offers his thanks and congratulations to Dorval's elected officials and employees for their efforts during the pandemic, for keeping the City running smoothly. He enjoys the prompt "Coronavirus" electronic newsletters that provide accurate information and states that seeing and hearing the citizens' questions and their answers during the webcast is informative. He asks 1) if resident **Mike Nizzola**, who asked questions during the February and March council meetings, will be a candidate for the upcoming municipal election. If that is the case, he feels that his questions and motives are not in the spirit of fair play; 2) for a follow-up on the **Dorval Circle refection work** and if the work will affect the traffic between Dorval South and Dorval North this summer; and 3) if various health related buildings in our community are exempt from **taxes** or if they benefit from reduced tax rates.
- 9. A resident of **chemin du Bord-du-Lac—Lakeshore** asks 1) if the **councillor** who did not comply with the municipal regulations intends to donate \$1,500 to three charitable organizations; 2) to improve the safety of cyclists by encouraging them to take the bike path on Dawson; and 3) suggests the adoption of a resolution that would require future candidates to take an IQ test before standing as candidates for a **municipal election**.
