



Excerpt of the minutes of the council meeting held on Monday, June 20, 2022

1.1 Question Period and Receipt of Petitions

1. A resident of Ferndale Avenue requests a follow-up on his complaint regarding his neighbor's **carport** which is causing him inconvenience and water accumulation on his property.
2. A resident of l'Académie Avenue requests a follow-up regarding the **construction project at Collège Ste-Anne** and would like to see a plan or a model to know more about the project.
3. A resident of Boylan Avenue asks whether the **fence** at the end of Boylan Avenue could be repaired.
4. A resident of Picard Place asks whether the City could intervene with the **Ministère des Transports** to expedite the work thus allowing cyclists to use the overpass' sidewalk at the Dorval roundabout instead of using the Dorval intermodal station's pedestrian tunnel.
5. A resident of Carson Avenue asks why the **stop signs** at the intersections are in English and if the City will install the **traffic lights** at the corner of Carson and Roy to ensure the safety of the public.
6. A resident of Lilas Avenue asks the following questions regarding **12 Dahlia Avenue**:
1) whether a cedar hedge could be installed along her fence to ensure her privacy, security and tranquility; 2) whether it would be possible to limit and secure access to the premises; and 3) what type of dock will be installed and how close will it be to her property.
7. Residents of Girouard and Dahlia avenues ask whether the neighbouring residences of 12 Dahlia will be consulted regarding the **installation of the dock** and the activities that will be permitted there.



8. A resident of Dahlia Avenue requests a follow-up on the **St-Charles Park project**.
9. A resident of Vaudreuil-Dorion asks: 1) whether the City has had any verbal or written communications with Montreal-Trudeau International Airport (ADM) regarding **black carbon particles**; 2) how the City intends to act to protect its residents and whether it will be suing the ADM; and 3) whether a copy of the correspondence sent to federal and provincial ministers could be forwarded to him as agreed.
10. A resident of 2^e Avenue asks: 1) if the City objects to the increase in the **share payable to the Agglomeration**; 2) whether actions will be taken to optimize the integration of bus lines at future **REM** stations and thus better serve the Dorval population; and 3) what measures will be implemented to prevent backups of the **storm sewer on Roy Avenue**.
11. A resident of St-Charles Avenue asks: 1) what the City intends to do to mitigate the danger of **black carbon particles**; 2) the names of the members of the **Fund to Assist and Support Dorval Citizens' Committee**; 3) why a City employee planted flowers in front of **Bijouterie Aubry** and whether this service is offered to other residents; and 4) How much did the purchase of **12 Dahlia Avenue** cost and why did the City not purchase the McConnell Woods.
12. A resident of Neptune Avenue: 1) asks whether the City will form a **local heritage council**; 2) requests a follow-up on his proposal to add **7 buildings of heritage interest** to the existing list; 3) asks why the addition of the definition of **'Redevelopment Project'** to the Zoning By-law is not subject to the approval of those eligible to vote.
13. A resident of Girouard Avenue asked whether the City would consider selling a portion of the land at **12 Dahlia Avenue** to the adjacent residences on the condition that the land and the trees be preserved as green space.
14. A resident of McNicoll Crescent: 1) requests a follow-up regarding the complaint about the property located at **320 Clement Avenue** which is further from the public thoroughfare than the neighbouring properties, thus possibly violating the City's SPAIP By-law; 2) asks how the City will ensure the **safety of children going to school** in Gentilly considering the ongoing construction on Carson Avenue and the upcoming construction on Dawson Avenue for the Dorval Alternative Home; and 3) requests a follow-up on the progression of the **hiring process for the future Director General**.
15. A resident of Dahlia Avenue asks whether the residents of Dahlia Avenue will be consulted on the new vocation of **12 Dahlia Avenue** considering that they live nearby.



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16. A resident of St-Charles Avenue requests a follow-up on the acquisition of **Pointe-Picard**.
17. A resident of Dahlia Avenue requests a follow-up on the **wire burial project** on Bord-du-Lac—Lakeshore.
