1.2 Question Period and Receipt of Petitions

1. A resident of Fénélon Boulevard asks what the **naming process** is for municipal buildings and public spaces.
2. A resident of Picard Place proposes a solution for the construction of **a bicycle path** to connect the southern and the northern sectors of the City.
3. A resident of Lagacé Avenue: 1) requests a follow-up on the planting of **native plant species** in the City's parks and gardens; 2) asks whether the City could intervene with **dog owners** who do not pick up after their dogs; and 3) asks whether the City is considering banning **noisy yardwork** on Sundays during a certain period of the year as is the case in Senneville.
4. A resident of Cloverdale Avenue asks: 1) whether the **Golf Dorval** course is rented from ADM for \$1/month and is exempt from municipal taxes; 2) whether the Golf Dorval corporation is responsible for the environmental protection of the building and the terrain; and 3) whether the financial statements of Golf Dorval are public and how the board members are chosen.
5. A resident of de l'Académie Avenue asks: 1) when the City will intervene to address the problems caused by the gatherings and traffic to get to the sports chalet built by **Collège Sainte-Anne**; and 2) what prevents the City from imposing the respect of the plans already approved in this project in order to preserve the privacy of the residences next to the College.
6. A resident of Monette Avenue complains that her neighbour always leaves his **garbage and recycling bins** in front of his property, as well as a steel beam on the side of her property.
7. A resident of chemin du Bord-du-Lac—Lakeshore asks why the City is planning to make changes to its **Sustainable Master Plan** and why not put this decision to a vote by residents.



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8. A resident of St-Charles Avenue reads the letter of **formal notice** he received from the City in relation to his comments made at the June council meeting and asks: 1) why the Mayor is ignoring a report by a McGill scientist on the harmful effects of **black carbon particles** from aircraft; 2) why the Mayor placed his **election signs** in the same locations where other candidates' signs had been vandalized; and 3) whether the Mayor can justify the \$8 million price paid for the property at **12 Dahlia Avenue** and whether the property has been inspected.
9. A resident of Saint-Louis Avenue mentions that he is pleased to see that there is development in the construction of the residence at 252 Clement Avenue. He requests: 1) a follow-up regarding the **former CHSLD** building on Herron Road; 2) a follow-up on the building formerly occupied by Novartis on Bouchard Boulevard; and asks : 3) whether the **new building on Reverchon Boulevard** at the site of the former truck warehouse is located in Dorval or Pointe-Claire; 4) if there is any development regarding **Pointe-Picard**; and 5) whether there are any projects on the parts of the **Golf Dorval** that belong to ADM.
10. A resident of Saint-Louis Avenue asks whether the building located at **165 Saint-Louis Avenue** would occupy the entire lot following the request for a minor variance.
11. A resident of Vaudreuil-Dorion: 1) requests to obtain a copy of the written correspondence to the **4 Ministers of Health and Environment** regarding **black carbon particles** and if the City did not communicate with them, why is that so; 2) asks whether the City will inform its residents of the adverse health effects of Dorval's air and that they should have MERV 15 filters or air cleaners with filters; and 3) asks on which sources the City bases its assertion that black carbon particles are dangerous or not.
