



Excerpt of the minutes of the council meeting held on Monday, October 17, 2022

1.2 Question Period and Receipt of Petitions

1. A resident of Mimosa Avenue proposes to open a **canine agility** centre in Dorval and asks if the City of Dorval could identify a site on its territory for the development of such centre.
2. A resident of Académie Avenue asks: 1) why the **sports chalet** was built on the west side of the school contrary to what was initially planned; 2) whether the City could intervene with regard to the noise pollution caused by gatherings and passers-by going to the chalet; and 3) whether there had been a public consultation to move the chalet to the west side.
3. A resident of Académie Avenue: 1) points out that the **sports chalet** was not on the initial plans presented by the Académie Sainte-Anne before construction; 2) complains about noise, invasion of privacy and waste left on site caused by the large volume of people and the increased traffic of **chalet users** near private properties; and 3) asks what the council proposes to **remedy the issues**.
4. A resident of Académie Avenue: 1) complains about the constant gatherings near private properties and the increased traffic along the private fences of residents caused by the construction of the Académie Sainte-Anne's **sports chalet**; 2) requests **council's support** to help residents resolve this issue; and 3) complains about parents' dangerous driving and non-compliance with road safety rules on **Académie Avenue** when picking up their children from school and asks what council plans to do to solve the issue.
5. A resident of Académie Avenue: 1) points out that the **sports chalet** was shown on the site plan approved by the City's Urban Planning Department at the same location it is currently built; 2) proposes to **move the chalet** to remedy the problems that its current location poses; and 3) complains about the **increased traffic** of passers-by on the road along the fence of private properties and laid out for the exclusive access of emergency vehicles.



6. A resident of chemin du Bord-du-Lac—Lakeshore asks: 1) whether increased police surveillance would be possible as well as one or two additional stop signs or traffic lights near the SDCC and a little further west to reduce **speeding** on chemin du Bord-du-Lac—Lakeshore and 2) why there is no **organic waste pickup** program in the condos on Académie Avenue.
7. A resident of Académie Avenue asks: 1) explanations regarding the property **assessment method** for properties on the assessment roll; and 2) whether there will be an increase in **municipal taxes** in Dorval in 2023.
8. A resident of Académie Avenue asks why the temporary **no-parking** street signs are not put up earlier in the day when municipal works are scheduled for the evening.
9. A resident of Claude Avenue requests a follow-up regarding the **fall of branches** from an old tree on his property.
10. A resident of Thorncrest Avenue: 1) asks for clarifications regarding the **payment of commercial taxes** by a contractor who has a registered business in a residential area in Dorval; and 2) complains about residents **tying up their dog** in their front yard, resulting in the dog barking at people passing by.
11. A resident of Neptune Avenue requests a follow-up on: 1) the progress of the restoration work on the **stone walls** at the entrance to **Saint-Charles Park**; and 2) the stone walls at the entrance of **McConnell Road**.
12. A resident of Handfield Avenue asks if tools other than technological ones could be used to notify the population of **boil-water advisories** and if Public Security could drive through the City streets with a megaphone next time.
13. A resident of Boylan Avenue: 1) asks why the City did not pay more attention to the water pressure drop and the colour of the water the morning before the announcement of the **boil-water advisory**; 2) asks for explanations regarding the decrease in the number of **recreational swimming lanes** available at the Dorval Aquatic and Sports Complex; and 3) requests a copy of the agreement between the City and the **centre de services scolaire Marguerite-Bourgeoys**.
14. A resident of McNicoll Crescent requests explanations regarding: 1) the City's **Sustainable Master Plan review process**; 2) the **development projects** on Bouchard Avenue, Dorval Avenue and the triangular area between Côte-de-Liesse Road, Highway 20 and 55th Avenue; and 3) high-density **development projects** east of Dorval Avenue and the voting rights of residents affected by these projects.



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15. A resident of St-Charles Avenue asks: 1) why the City of Dorval did not promote the **debate session of the 5 candidates in the provincial elections** co-hosted by the mayors of Lachine and Dorval in the context of the October provincial elections; 2) why the Mayor mentioned that he has a **university degree**; and 3) why Councillor Von Roretz did not insist on being on the selection committee during the **hiring process** for the new City Director General and why did he not exercise his due diligence before voting on this important matter.
16. A resident of Vaudreuil-Dorion requested a follow-up on: 1) communications with Professor Parisa Ariya of McGill University regarding **black carbon particles**; and 2) communications with the Ministry of Transport regarding the issue of **black carbon particles**.
