1. The residents of Handfield Circle, Neptune Avenue, McNicoll Crescent and Boylan Avenue, request access to the **report relating to urban planning** before it is presented to citizens on April 24th and 25th, 2023.
2. A resident of Place Picard asks questions concerning the **cycling network** planning study prepared by the firm AECOM.

(Councillor Pascal Brault intervenes after having obtained the Mayor's authorization and informs the resident about the City's intentions regarding the planning of the cycling network and encourages the resident to attend the CMM's public hearings).

3. A resident of 5th Avenue asks questions concerning **permits to fell or prune trees**.
4. A resident of Martin Avenue invokes a possible drainage problem since the resumption of the work in the **St-Charles Park** parking lot.
5. A resident of Girouard Avenue asks questions concerning: 1) **St-Charles Park**; 2) **Ballantyne Pool**; and 3) the addition of free hockey and stick and puck activity to the public skating period at the **Edgar Rouleau Arena**.
6. Two residents of chemin du Bord-du-Lac-Lakeshore ask if the City of Dorval has **asbestos** water pipes.
7. A resident of Clément Avenue asks questions concerning: 1) **day camps**; 2) **salaries of camp monitors**; and 3) **lack of camp monitors**.
8. A resident of St-Léon Avenue asks questions concerning: 1) **Barbada's** participation in the Story Time Club; 2) the **street painting** at the corner of chemin du Bord-du-Lac-Lakeshore and Pine Beach; and 3) the presence of **fluoride** in drinking water.
9. Two residents of Louise-Lamy Avenue ask questions concerning the **Jardins Dorval project**.
10. A resident of 5th Avenue asks if vehicles leaving the **Jardins Dorval project** parking lot could be directed east on Carson.
11. A resident of Pine Beach Avenue asks whether **underground power lines** would be possible to avoid major power outages like those of April 5th.

12. A resident of Vaudreuil-Dorion asks questions concerning **back carbon nanoparticles**.
13. A resident of Lachine asks questions concerning **basketball courts**.
14. A resident of Handfield Circle asks questions concerning: 1) the structure of meetings with **developers**; and 2) increasing the percentage of **green spaces** in Dorval.
15. A resident of Neptune Avenue asks questions concerning: 1) the presentation process of the **report on urban planning**; and 2) the stone walls of the **McConnell Estate**.
16. A resident of Handfield Crescent asks questions concerning: 1) the **Fund to Assist and Support Dorval Citizens**; 2) **cultural activities** and the existence or not of a cultural committee within the City; and 3) the maximum height of **hedges** allowed in Dorval.
17. A resident of John-Pratt Avenue asks a question concerning the establishment of a location to be used to offer **performing arts** shows.
18. A resident of McNicoll Crescent asks various questions concerning the fire at **440 Gallant**; and 2) the preservation of **archaeological sites** on private lands.
19. A resident of chemin du Bord-du-Lac-Lakeshore asks questions concerning: 1) the **chemin du Bord-du-Lac-Lakeshore** revitalization project; 2) the audit and the heritage study relating to the building on **12, Dahlia**; and 3) the **Master Plan for Parks and Leisure and Culture Facilities**.
20. A resident of Mousseau-Vermette Avenue asks questions concerning: 1) **citizen consultations** by the firm BC2; 2) **affordable housing**; and 3) the **contracts awarded** to the firm BC2 by the City.
21. A resident of Dawson Avenue asks questions concerning: 1) the presence of **potholes** on City's territory; 2) maintenance of **public trees** in parks; and 3) Dorval **Fitness Centre** membership fees.
22. A resident of Saint-Charles Avenue asks questions concerning: 1) the **Committee for the Integration of Individuals with Disabilities in Dorval**; 2) a follow-up on an **access to information** request; and 3) the **Bouchard Creek**.
