1.2 Question Period and Receipt of Petitions

- A resident of Dawson Avenue inquires about: 1) radon testing in Dorval homes;
 tax revenues from the Bell building on Bouchard Boulevard; and 3) communications to residents during municipal work on public roads.
- 2. A resident of Élie-De Bellefeuille Avenue inquires about: 1) the eight-storey limit in sector 4 of the new Sustainable Master Plan at the corner of Herron and Fénelon; and 2) citizen participation in the upcoming revision of the SPAIP.
- 3. A resident of Élie-De Bellefeuille Avenue inquires about the zoning amendments made by By-law RCM-60A-17-2023, particularly: 1) the reaction of developers in sector 4; 2) the shopping centre at 900-960 Herron Road; and 3) the maximum height permitted in this sector.
- 4. A resident of Boylan Avenue inquires about: 1) leaf collection service; and 2) the sale of the land at **565 Pine Beach**.
- 5. A resident of de l'Église Avenue asks a question regarding road safety at the intersection of Dawson and Lilas avenues.

6. A resident of Ferndale Crescent asks a question about parking on the **bike path** on Dawson Avenue.

7. A resident of McNicoll Crescent inquires about: 1) the upcoming revision of the SPAIP; 2) the projected increase in the number of housing units in Dorval; and 3) the City's **privacy policy**.



- 8. A resident of St-Charles Avenue inquires about: 1) the council's **decision-making process** when awarding contracts; 2) the green space at **Garden Crescent**; and 3) the development of the area where the Bell building is located on **Bouchard Boulevard**.
- 9. A resident of Vaudreuil-Dorion inquires about: 1) carbon black nanoparticles; 2) visibility triangles at intersections.
